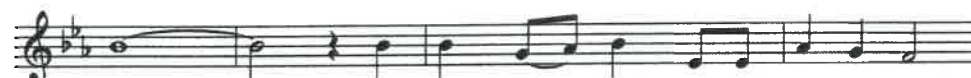

## The Nicene Creed




### Offertory Hymn: *Set Your Heart on the Higher Gifts*


